

ICD10 Implementation Notice

In the newsletter sent out on July 26th, 2015 (see attachment), we explained the new ICD10 functionality that we programmed into Planetrehab. The mandated change goes into effect on October 1st, 2015, meaning all claims MUST be submitted with an ICD10 and not an ICD9. On and after October 1st, Planetrehab will not submit a claim that does not have an ICD10.

Our goal is to make sure claims submitted via Planetrehab with an ICD10 are processed without interruption. We have done a tremendous amount of work to crosswalk existing ICD9 codes to the appropriate ICD10 codes. For all existing patients in your database, Planetrehab will automatically use the correct ICD10 based on your currently selected ICD9 code when submitting on October 1st, 2015 and thereafter. We have made it virtually foolproof. Therefore, we strongly urge you not to change the ICD9 code(s) on any existing patients.

However, any new evaluations on or after October 1st, 2015 should have the most specific ICD10 code possible since ICD10 codes are much more specific than ICD9 codes. You may have to add a specific ICD10 code to your database. As with most functions in Planetrehab, adding a code is very easy. The detailed instructions are included in the attached PDF.
